

South House Covid-19 Policy

Approved: July 6, 2022

1 MASK REQUIREMENT

1.1 Masks must be worn inside of South House and during all events hosted by South House, unless eating or drinking, physically distanced by 6 feet and seated.

1.2 Surgical (3 ply) masks or equivalent, must be worn.

1.3 Surgical (3 ply) masks will be provided by the South House at the Center and all South House in person events.

2 PHYSICAL DISTANCING

2.1 If eating and drinking, individuals or bubbles must be physically distanced (both inside and outside) by 6 feet.

3 SCREENING AND CASE REPORTING

3.1 All staff, board, and volunteers entering the South House or attending an in person South House event must complete the following screening prior to entering the space. If the answer is YES to any of the questions the individual must leave the space.

- I. Are you currently experiencing any of the following symptoms (new or worsening): sore throat, nasal congestion, shortness of breath, fever or cough?
- II. Have you, anyone in your household, or someone you have been in close contact with tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days?

3.2 Staff, board, or volunteers who have tested COVID-19 positive are required to report receiving this test result to the board if present at the South House or an in person South House event. All members in contact with the individual between the time of exposure and the date of the positive test should be notified of the positive case if we have their contact information.

4 CENTER SUPPLIES AND SIGNAGE

4.1 The South House will stock the following supplies for staff, volunteer, and community use:

- I. Hand sanitizer
- II. 3 ply surgical masks
- III. Disinfectant spray

4.2 Signage will be displayed at the South House outlining mask and physical distancing requirements.
